The unfinished task of the great commission is dependent, in large part, on financial and human resources. It is estimated that 99.9% of all Christian giving benefits the already-evangelized world, meaning only 0.01% of Christian financial resources are directed to reach those who have never heard the name of Jesus. It costs foreign missionary \$25,000 per single or \$50,000 per couple on the field. By comparison, NHMI national workers in West Africa need only \$2,500-\$3,000 annually to carry the gospel to their people.

In the context of West Africa, NHMI believe we must encourage the supporting of national workers. That is why we offer you an opportunity to

help us meet our challenges. Our work is being done in a largely Muslim cultural context. Through "Gift to the Nations" you can help meet some of the very practical needs we have on the field.

Our purpose this year, is to mobilize resources to help us fund some of the projects we have in the countries we are involved in. We invite you to consider prayerfully making a special donation to these strategic projects.

# GIFTS TO THE NATIONS THAT YOU CAN GIVE

## **Sponsorship of church planters and evangelists**

NHMI has five church planters and evangelists working in small towns and villages in Togo. The families of the new church planting stations are not able to support them and their families. Support one church planter or evangelist and his family for \$150 per month, or \$1,800 annually.

## **Evangelism outreach and church planting team**

NHMI has formed and trained two outreach teams in Togo for targeted areas. The work involves starting church planting stations among unevangelized groups in remote areas. This project directly supports the teams in transportation, food, accommodations, the Jesus Film, lamps, gasoline for generators, literature to hand out, etc... Funds needed for the whole year for the four countries: \$2,000.

## **Field office equipment: computers and printers**

Although administration may not seem like a very exciting place to send your gift, it is absolutely necessary. This project will help purchase: two desk top computers, two printers, two laptop computers and office furniture. Total funds needed: \$4,000.

## **Motorbikes for church planters and district pastors**

A motorbike is an extremely useful and time-saving tool for our district pastors and church planters. It allows them to visit church planting stations and church planters in their villages and towns. This project provides funds to buy three motorbikes. Cost of three motorbikes: \$3,000.

## **Leadership Meeting**

NHMI would like to gather its leaders and pastors for a time of spiritual learning and renewal. Leaders of the church in Togo will gather nationally to discuss strategies to grow the young denomination and to strengthen the unity of its leaders. Total funds needed for transportation, conference materials, food, and lodging for 55 workers: \$5,000 (\$90 per leader).



## **Church buildings in rural Togo**

The churches in the rural towns of Tabligbo and Glei have each purchased a plot of land. They wish to build simple shelters to allow them space to worship. They will provide manpower for the project. The funds needed to build both shelters: \$4,000.

## **Theological education scholarships**

### **For WATI-Togo students**

(WATI is the West Africa Theological Institute)

As the church in Togo grows more churches are being planted. The demand for trained pastors is great. However, the cost of training is high. This funding enables 13 current pastoral students to receive theological education (BA & MA in Theology) in preparation for pastoral ministry in French West Africa. This training entails 2-week sessions for 9 months during each of the next 3 years. Funds requested will cover books, transportation, tuition, food, internship in a church, and administrative expenses. The cost for annually per student: \$800. Each student will contribute \$200. Funds needed for 13 Students annually: \$7,800.

## **Urban land lease for 5 years in Lome, capital city of Togo**

The Emmaus congregation in the capital city of Lome is growing and needs a new space for worship but is having difficulty a suitable property that is affordable. This project will help lease land on which to build a temporary worship shelter until the church is able financially to buy a land and build its own chapel. A larger property will allow the church to have office and worship space. Funds requested: \$ 2,000 per year.

## **Chicken farm**

The churches in Assahoun and Tsevie are currently working to establish a trial chicken farm. The purpose of this project is to generate sufficient funds to support two church planters, two pastors, and their families in the district. The projection is that the chicken farm should be self supporting within a year. Funds needed to start this project: \$3,500.
